Hematology Analyzer \$40,100

A hematology analyzer is a laboratory instrument used to analyze and count the components of blood, most commonly in a Complete Blood Count (CBC) test. Hematology analyzers are critical for diagnosing and monitoring conditions such as:

- Anemia
- Infections
- Leukemia
- Clotting disorders
- Immune system issues



These machines are widely used in hospital labs, outpatient clinics, and diagnostic centres because they provide fast, accurate, and automated blood analysis with minimal sample volume.



🗹 🛛 Electrocardiogram Carts \$50,130

An electrocardiogram (ECG or EKG) cart is a mobile unit that holds and transports the equipment needed to perform an electrocardiogram—a test that measures the electrical activity of the heart.

physiological indicators, which help assess patient's health status and detect medical concerns. These indicators including blood pressure, heart rate,

Ultrasound Machine & Suite \$179,940

In 2024, the Foundation funded the purchase and installation of a second ultrasound unit for South Huron Hospital. The addition of this unit has already proven to reduce wait times, and in 2024 our Diagnostic Imaging team completed 300 more ultrasound exams than in 2023.

Ultrasound imaging, or sonography, is a safe, non-invasive diagnostic tool that uses high-frequency sound waves to produce real-time images of the body's internal structures. This versatile and cost-effective technology is widely used in obstetrics, gynecology, cardiac, vascular, and musculoskeletal imaging. The addition of a second ultrasound machine at South Huron Hospital has significantly reduced patient wait times, allowing for faster diagnoses, more timely treatments, and enhanced patient comfort.

This upgrade increases the hospital's diagnostic capacity, enabling more patients to be scanned daily, even during busy periods. As a small rural hospital without access to advanced imaging modalities like CT, MRI, or nuclear medicine, ultrasound remains the most accessible and essential diagnostic tool for the community. With two ultrasound machines, South Huron Hospital provides timely, comprehensive care—improving early detection, supporting proactive health management, and ensuring patients can receive care close to home.

The South Huron Hospital Auxiliary 💎

The South Huron Hospital Auxiliary has been working as a volunteer non-profit organization to support the care given at the South Huron Hospital since 1953. They are a dedicated group of approximately 150 members who work tirelessly to serve the hospital and patients through their gift shop profits, rummage sales, and special fundraising endeavors.
